## WYSA REC SOCCER CODE OF CONDUCT

## Parents/Guardians/Spectators:

- 1. Show respect at all times to players, coaches, officials and opposing teams; failure to do so can result in ejection from the facility.
- 2. Refrain from criticizing coaches in public; please discuss any issues with the coach/rec director in private.
- 3. Expect your child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without interruption.
- 4. Do not ridicule any child for making a mistake during the course of a game.
- 5. Parents are not allowed in the playing field during practices or games; this is to make sure coaches can effectively work with the team.
- 6. Remember that coaches are volunteers and should be thanked for their efforts.
- 7. Promote the success and well-being of the entire team ahead of any personal desire you may have for your child alone.
- 8. Emphasize skill development and improvement over winning.
- 9. Be responsible for all family members and friends attending games to watch your child.
- 10. Remember the game is for our youth, not the adults; the players participate to have fun and learn the game.

## Coaches/Volunteers:

- 1. Be an example of good sportsmanship to players, parents, spectators, and officials.
- 2. Have a positive approach to players, using constructive feedback rather than criticism.
- 3. Focus on teamwork and effort, not just winning games.
- 4. Address issues in private with the Rec Director if a situation requires attention.
- 5. Accept decisions made by the referees. When there are questions or disputes directed towards a referee, handle it in a mature and professional manner which exhibits positive behavior.
- 6. Require equal effort and commitment from each player.
- 7. Follow the league rules and make sure all players understand and play by those rules.
- 8. Keep parents informed of game and practice schedules and changes to those schedules as soon as possible.
- 9. Address issues of unsportsmanlike conduct immediately with the Rec Director.
- 10. Be responsible for the equipment used during practices and games.

## Players:

- 1. Be a respectful and cooperative player/teammate that models good sportsmanship.
- 2. Follow and understand the rules at all times.
- 3. Listen to the coaches and referees without complaint.
- 4. Attend all practices and games; if unable to attend please notify the coaches in advance.
- 5. Wear all required equipment to practices and games.
- 6. Be a positive role model for your teammates and opposing players.
